A Humble Beginning

The **PICE Qatar Chapter** was established in Doha, Qatar, on 25 May 2007 by twenty five Filipino Civil Engineers. These 25 Founding Members hailed from different regions of the Philippines and were employed by various engineering and construction companies involved in various aspects of civil engineering and construction activities in the development of State of Qatar.

The Founding Members elected among themselves a set of Interim Officers to run the affairs of the new professional organization headed by **Engr. Roy L. Baquiran** as its Founding President. On 17 June 2007, the PICE Qatar Chapter was recognized by the Philippine Embassy in Qatar, through H.E. Ambassador Isaias F. Begonia, as a non-profit organization of Filipino Civil Engineers working in the State of Qatar, dedicated to establishing and maintaining an organization that embodies the common ideals and aspirations, and supports the continuing professional development of its members through education and training with newly established engineering information and advancements through lectures, seminars and research. During the following months, a massive information campaign was launched and membership registration drive was carried out.

The establishment of the PICE Qatar Chapter was warmly received by significant number of Qatar based Filipino Civil Engineers who joined the organization and registered with the Chapter. On 21 September 2007, the PICE Qatar Chapter request for accreditation was approved by the PICE National Board through the National President Juanito P. Abergas and Chapter Affairs Committee Chairman Ronaldo S. Ison. The PICE Qatar Chapter is now recognized as a **PICE International Chapter - Charter No. 03**.

Primary Objectives of PICE QATAR Chapter

- 1.1** To facilitate the continuing professional development of its members by showcasing the latest Civil Engineering technology through education and training with newly established engineering information and advancements through but not limited to lectures, seminar/workshops, researches, online forum and other means of educational information available.
- 1.2** To establish and maintain a support system within the general membership by:
 - 1.2.1** Pooling resources and extending a helping hand to laid-off / denied re-employment colleagues in the Civil Engineering profession with a No Objection Certificate to find new employment in Qatar and where possible within the Gulf region.
 - 1.2.2** Extending assistance to concerned members in time of need and to charitable Institution/s for distribution to calamity affected recipients in the Philippines.
 - 1.2.3** Facilitating programs for the reintegration of the PICE QATAR CHAPTER members into the Philippine community.
- 1.3** To facilitate an information network among the PICE QATAR CHAPTER members by means of media, internet, or other means of communication.
- 1.4** To foster a spirit of pride, responsibility and camaraderie in the civil engineering profession.
- 1.5** To present a visible symbol identifying the Civil Engineers in Qatar by affiliating and reintegrating our Organization with other international organizations who have similar, if not the same, common goals as professionals in the field of engineering.
- 1.6** To assist concerned members in the renewal of their PRC license and other concerns relating to the Institute.
- 1.7** To encourage and to assist interested Associate Members by organizing and conducting Civil Engineering review classes prior to the examinations to prepare themselves in taking the Special Professional Licensure Examinations (SPLE) in Qatar which is sanctioned by the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC).

COHOOPLE has undertaken and successfully conducted review classes that actually started on October 5, 2018 and carried-over to the current fiscal year

- **November 2018** - The SPLE review started on October 5, 2018 with 36 students. It was also announced that we are still accepting new enrollees. 9 enrollees additional attended the 2nd session of SPLE review on October 12, 2018. As on October 26, 2018, 56 enrollees with 50 attendees at present. Photoshoot of COHOOPLE Committee members also held at Oryx Rotana Hotel for GA magazine
- **December 2018** - As on this month, there were 58 enrollees and the average attendees were 40 students.
- By January 2019, major subjects will be the next to be discussed on our SPLE review course.
- **January 2019** - There were 61 enrollees to date and the average attendees for SPLE review were 40 students. The lessons were Surveying, Engineering Mechanics, Strength of Materials, Transportation Engineering, Theory of Structures, and introduction of Fluid Mechanics.

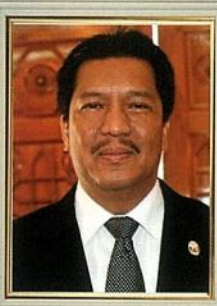

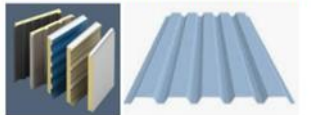
